Summary of Main Activities

The Campus Facilities Planning Committee was created in 2014 as part of the introduction of improved Shared Governance arrangements for the review of capital projects. The Committee met seven times between September 2014 and April 2015 and engaged in discussions with Linda Eastley, Master Planner, and Meredith Elbaum, Sustainability Consultant, as well as with Heiddi Davis, Director of Planning, Design and Construction, and Karlan Seville, Communications Manager. The main agenda items were:

- **Review of the Campus Infill Study:** East Campus, Medical Campus, Athletics – in-depth review of the findings of the Infill Study Technical Group on the potential for future development within the campus consistent with Master Plan Principles.
- **Project Reviews:** Review of proposals for renovations (Stewart Hall, Lafferre Hall), additions (Hill Hall/Townsend Hall, Missouri Orthopaedic Institute), and new build (Veterinary Medicine Ambulatory Teaching Facility).
- **Linkages with Other Campus Plans:** Consideration of the interaction between Campus Master Plan and Landscape Master Plan, Sustainability/Climate Action Plan, Utility Master Plan, and Stormwater Master Plan.
- **2015 Campus Master Plan and Climate Action Plan Update:** Review of drafts of plan document and of presentation for April 13, 2015 public meeting.
