

**2001-2002 Hearnes Center Advisory Committee  
ANNUAL REPORT**

The Hearnes Center Advisory Committee met twice during the year: October 29, 2001 and on May 17, 2002. There were 11 members in attendance at the first meeting; 8 members attended the second meeting.

The charge to the Committee (as presented and discussed at the first meeting) was to:

Advise the Director of Athletics on programs, services, and policies for the Hearnes Center. This committee also acts upon appeals in decisions of the Director in implementing the policies.

The October 2001 and the May 2002 meetings primarily focused on the use of the Hearnes Center and updates associated with the new arena.

The following recommendations/observations were presented for consideration:

1. The Hearnes Center Advisory Committee again recommends that the \$4 Multi-Purpose Building fee be split in such a way that one-half of the fee is used to fund the maintenance of Jesse Auditorium.
2. The Hearnes Center Advisory Committee encourages the Hearnes Center to develop a written policy concerning the sale of alcohol at Hearnes Center events.
3. The Hearnes Center Advisory Committee recommends that the north entrance of the Hearnes Center be evaluated to determine what renovation is needed for handicapped access at this entrance. The Hearnes Center Advisory Committee supports the use of "the student fee" should funds be needed to remodel this entrance for handicapped access.
4. The Hearnes Center Advisory Committee recommends that the Hearnes Center evaluate how the Hearnes Center should/can modernize the existing lighting system. For example, special dimmer switches could be installed that would facilitate Hearnes Center Events.
5. The Hearnes Center Advisory Committee recommends that the Hearnes Center evaluate lighting that automatically shuts off when the lights are left on in a room that is unattended (vacant).
6. The Hearnes Center Advisory Committee commends the Athletic Department for putting a new ticket system in place (the voucher system) to correct the problems encountered during one of the men's BB game.
