SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION ITEMS/ACTIVITIES OF COMMITTEE

We heard 23 appeals from out-of-state students this past year, 17 cases in 2014 and 6 cases in 2015. Most, but not all of the verdicts were consistent with the Admissions Office (denials). Each student hearing lasted about 30 minutes. On average, each meeting (consisting of several students) lasted over two hours. The terms of service for Matthew Bernard, Ellie Ragland, and Neil Raymon expired, but we added three more faculty / staff to our roster: Steven Lambson, Robert Smale, and Lea Brandt. Most committee members were present for each of the hearings. We have adjourned for the academic year.
