**SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION ITEMS/ACTIVITIES OF COMMITTEE**

We heard 17 appeals from out-of-state students this past year, 8 cases in 2016 and 9 cases in 2017. Most, but not all of the verdicts were consistent with the Admissions Office (denials). Each student hearing lasted about 30 minutes. On average, each meeting (consisting of several students) lasted about two hours. We added three faculty to our membership: Haley Horstman, Erika Lietzan, and Amy Simons. We have adjourned for the academic year.
