of times committee met: The committee met twice (on 12-09-2016 and 04-09-2017) to process five Stage-3 appeals during the 2016-2017 academic year.

Major accomplishments or highlights

This committee works on an “as needed” basis to process Stage-2 and Stage-3 traffic ticket appeals. Stage-2 cases are assigned by the parking office to individual committee members using e-mail and the “box” online storage. The parking office works with the committee to schedule meetings for Stage-3 in-person appeals.

During the 2016-2017 academic year, the committee processed a total of 64 stage-2 cases and five stage-3 cases.

Recommendations for next year

The staff members at the parking office have done a great job processing initial ticket appeals and significantly reduced the number of cases going for the stage-2 and -3 appeals. The current process is working well and no major change is recommended for this committee.
